DESCRIPTION

The AIR-EAGLE XLT, MODEL 44-1800-120I-120VAC is an R.F. transmitter capable of sending eight 120VAC input commands to an Air-Eagle XLT Receiver. Any number of transmitters and receivers can be combined to create a long range radio frequency system that operates hazardous or hard-to-reach electrical apparatus from safe, convenient locations of up to 2500 feet away (Up to 2 mile range with optional antennas). This unit is user-programmable for up seven network frequencies to allow multiple systems to operate simultaneously in the same area without interference.

INSTALLATION

DISCONNECT Power from all equipment before installation.

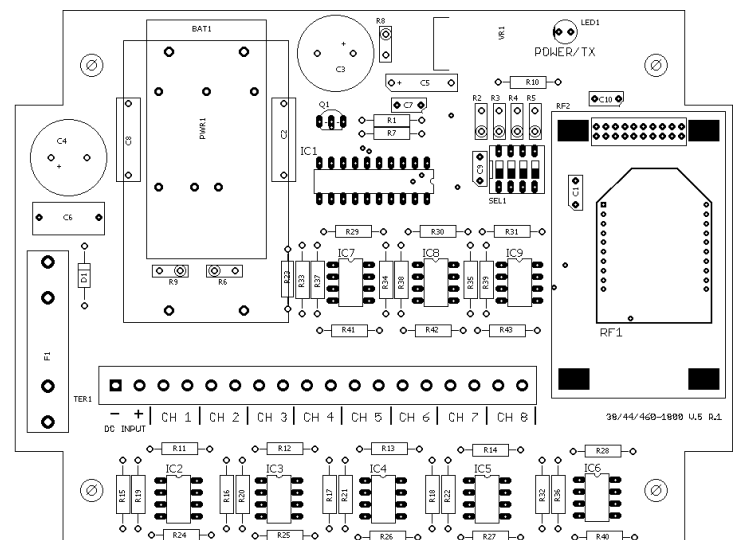
1. Mount the transmitter in a convenient location.
2. Install input wiring to TER1.
3. Attach supplied rubber duck antenna to TNC connector on the right side of the unit.
4. Plug supplied 120VAC wall plug into 110VAC outlet.

- 5) Programming is now complete.

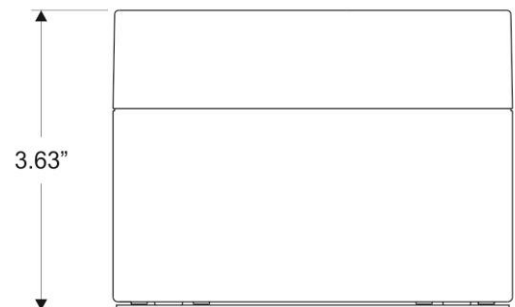
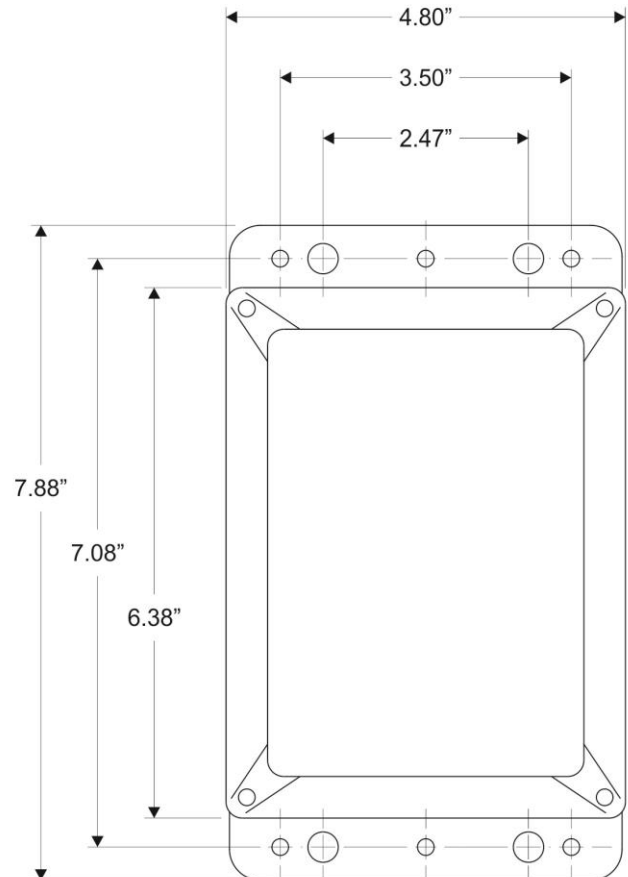
